

30 Second Auditions : Male Marine

If you are interested in playing one of the Marine Corps characters, please pick ONE of the 3 monologues from below.

The first monologue is very dramatic and is written to show the actors ability to change quickly from one emotion to the other. The Character is talking about himself and spots someone in the crowd that's not supposed to be there.

The second and third monologues are designed to highlight the actors ability to become the character, and show emotion while telling a story.

Cpl Wright

NOW SIR! I'm Counting to 3! 1...2...3! (Actor puts his "imaginary" weapon down quickly and screams.) NOOOOO!

He's already been "slated" to go to The Desert in the next couple months, but I don't think I'll go for a while cause my leg is still a little messed up from Bootcamp. I keep saying I'm fine, but the doc says I can't go anywhere. I joined to fight though - you know? I would walk on my hands to get a chance to be a hero (Laughs). More than anything though, I just wish I was there with my brother.
